

PHOENIX POLICE REPORT # 2020-1711113

On October 18, 2020, at approximately 0139 hours, 63K officers responded to a shots fired emergency call for service at 57XX East Campo Bello Drive. Upon arrival they located the victim with a gunshot wound through his right shoulder. The victim was transported to John C Lincoln Deer Valley with non-life threatening injuries. There were five vehicles and five houses struck by the gunfire. Detectives and CSS recovered over 100 casings from the scene. The victim was interviewed at the hospital and stated he was at the listed residence promoting his music when he was involved in a physical altercation with unknown subjects. The victim cannot identify who shot him and does not desire prosecution.

As more patrol units were responding they located a 2017 Dodge Durango leaving the neighborhood at a high rate of speed. A traffic stop was conducted and officers contacted the driver and three other occupants. Officers ordered all the occupants out of the vehicle and a Beretta .40 handgun was found in plain sight on the driver's floorboard. The occupants were detained and the driver was found to be a prohibited possessor. None of the four subjects admitted to being involved in the shooting. Driver was booked on one-count of misconduct involving weapons.

Crime Scene Specialist responded to assist in the investigation.

A search warrant was authored for 57XX East Campo Bello Drive and the five related vehicles.

The five homes that were struck by gunfire were processed for evidence.

*Over 100 shell casings.

*Investigated Lead buccal swabs
